Hockey's governing body the International Hockey Federation (FIH) is protecting the environment by challenging manufacturers to develop surfaces that will meet FIH international playing standards but crucially do not rely on large volumes of water to support performance.

TigerTurf have taken that challenge and researched varns, sand dressed carpets and consulted with

international players and coaches, to find a definitive solution.

This product can be played on "wet" or dry, thereby dramatically reducing the overall consumption of water compared to the requirements of other turfs.

The implications are enormous for owners, users and of course the environment.





TigerTurf WETT For the game...

TigerTurf WETT is designed to bring hockey surface performance to the next level. With water an option not a necessity, players of all abilities can perform their skills on a safe, true and comfortable surface. No more "burn" from nylon or slip from 'sand dressed' polyethylene, just perfect performance rain or shine.

The extremely durable curly, polyethylene, monofilament fibres are similar in appearance to nylon blades, yet much softer with a "wet" feel to them. The density of these fibres absorbs the impact from the hockey stick, recovering immediately and ensuring consistent performance far longer than other types of yarn.

TigerTurf WETT can be laid over a variety of shockpads, making it the ideal surface for new pitches as well as upgrading existing systems.





TigerTurf WETT For the player...

Such innovative developments often come at a price. Yet the durability of the texturised polyethylene monofilament yarn in TigerTurf WETT means greater long-term value, with an extended warranty compared to other turfs.

Over the years the game of hockey has become faster with a greater array of skills and closer stick control, all possible on a wet surface. The ball runs smoothly on wet fibres at a pace dictated by the player not the ground.

With the extra durability and unique yarn in TigerTurf WETT, the player can relax knowing that ball roll speed with be consistent all over the pitch - dry or wet.



Each tuft contains specially curled monofilament fibres which provide the perfect platform for players of all abilities to perform and improve their skills. The waxy feel ensures feet can twist and turn safely, at speed and comfortably, whilst providing an encouraging feel under the stick for close ball skills.



Meeting the standard

TigerTurf WETT has been tested to current FIH standards and passes with flying colours, on insitu or pre-formed rubber shock pads. The curly yarns ensure no ball roll deviation from any direction whilst maintaining a fast pace in line with player's demands.

The unique yarn used has been designed not to shine when wet, or under floodlights, whilst holding moisture to its surface - benefitting the game and environment.

TigerTurf has developed the WETT surface using advanced fibre technology exclusive to TigerTurf.

TigerTurf WETT shows little sign of deformation after extensive wear tests and the "spring" in the fibre means it is safe to fall on, yet not too soft that players will tire out.

Independent tests show that TigerTurf WETT will perform in extreme temperatures and under the most intense UV conditions, providing longer life expectancy.
